From our Pastor...

We are entering into the Advent season. Advent is a season of preparation in which Christians look forward to the celebration of the coming of the Savior to earth. During this season we will gather and worship our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ who came to earth to save us from our sins. Each week we will light Advent candles that have symbolic meaning to us. Jesus is the light of the world that was born in Bethlehem to be the promised Prince of Peace. The act of lighting one more candle each week, on the four Sundays proceeding Christmas, tells of the increasingly brighter light of his coming and lead gradually to the blaze of light at the dawning of Christmas. There have been many meanings that have been attached to the advent candles. The one that we use recognizes the first candle as the Prophecy candle, announcing the period of waiting. The second candle is the Bethlehem candle, symbolic of the preparations being made to receive and cradle the Christ child. The third candle is the Shepherd's candle, which typifies the act of sharing Christ. The fourth candle is the Angel's candle of love and final coming. The fifth candle is the Christ candle, usually lit on Christmas Eve, in preparation for the full appearing of life in Jesus Christ. As we celebrate this Advent season, may your hearts be touched by the love of God and may your life shine with the light of life given to us by Jesus.
