WAIVER FORM

The Warrior Camp specified here is a Church-hosted event. Before deciding to send your child or teen to Warrior Camp, please understand that doing so involves some risk. We want you to be informed that Warrior Camp is a Camp Ministry which is distinguished in part by games, challenges, competitions, and activities that are physically intense in nature. If you do not wish for your child or teen to be involved in a Camp of this kind, then please execute your right to diligently prevent or remove your child or teen from participation. Warrior Camp and its leaders, and the leaders of the hosting church, are not legally or financially responsible for any injuries which may occur at Warrior Camp. In allowing my child or teen to attend Warrior Camp, I understand and accept that there are risks involved. I hereby release Warrior Camp and its leaders, as well as leaders from the hosting Church, from any and all liability. In the event that an incident or injury should occur, I will take no action, legal or otherwise, against Warrior Camp or its leaders. I will take no legal or personal action against the hosting church or its leadership. I also understand and accept that Warrior Camp and its leaders, as well as the leaders of the hosting church, are not in a position to amend, compensate, or otherwise provide additional redress for any injuries which may occur at Warrior Camp. Should I deem it necessary, it is my responsibility as the parent (or guardian) to discuss these risks with my child or teen before he attends Warrior Camp. In the unlikely event of injury, I understand that any costs associated with medical treatment for my child may be the responsibility of the Insurance Provider for the Hosting Church, or of my family's health insurance provider, or some combination of the two.

Overly unruly Campers may be sent home without refund, and should this need arise, parents will be contacted.

I understand that there are risks involved in this event, and, by signing below, I attest to my continuing desire that my child or teen attend Warrior Camp.

I also understand and consent to my child or teen being included in Warrior Camp media (photography, video, etc...) that may be captured at WARRIOR CAMP, and made available in merchandise, or posted in approved online venues for legitimate informational, recap, and/or promotional purposes, as deemed appropriate by the Warrior Camp and/or the Hosting Church Leadership. I also consent to the possibility that my child or teen may be filmed from above, etc... via camera drone.

WARRIOR CAMP PRIZE ELIGIBILITY

(This form is used for Warrior Camps of all ages)

At Warrior Camp, we're excited about the **possibility** of having a drawing or prize table in which your child or teen may win or obtain a Warrior Camp Prize. Warrior Camp Prizes may involve an element of risk. In our efforts to offer exciting prizes, they may also be intense, masculine, and unapologetically cool. Warrior Camp Prizes may require adult supervision depending on the age, capability, and responsibility of your child or teen, and parents may inherit some or all responsibility accompanying the prize. We don't want your child or teen to win a prize that you're not excited about, or that doesn't meet with your approval. Only the more "intense" prizes are listed below. Other Warrior Camp Prizes which have no inherent risk (i.e. candy, etc...) are not listed, and may also be awarded.

Out of respect for you as the parent, please note the prizes below, and inform your son of any prizes he is not to receive at this point in his life. Inform your son he is to honor and obey your instruction while he is at Warrior Camp regarding winning or pursuing these prizes. For example, "Josh, you're 10 years old now, and when you turn 11, not before, then you can own your own pocket knife, and if you obey me, then on your birthday, you and I will go shopping for it together."

Prizes will be generally appropriate to the target age of the given Warrior Camp. For example, we won't offer a machete to a 1st grader! However, every parent may have a slightly different rule for their home about what is "age-appropriate" and we want to respect each parent's "house rules." Also, this same form is used for pre-teen boys, as well as high-school students, so some of these prizes may be offered to the latter, but not to the former. Also, not every prize mentioned below may be offered at every Warrior Camp, and new prizes may be added to the prize roster at a given Warrior Camp which are not yet listed here. Relatedly, Warrior Camp is never the same for the same group twice, and as a result, not every WARRIOR CAMP will offer a prize drawing or prize giveaway. However, please review this prize roster, and talk to your son which prizes are not kosher and which ones are. Again, only the more intense prizes are listed below, and this page **only** applies in the event that we do in fact hold such a drawing, prize-giveaway, etc...
