

### A word from our Associate Pastor

"How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of those who bring good news, who proclaim peace who bring good tidings, who proclaim salvation who say to Zion "Your God reigns!"

In the New Testament, the 'Good News' is the Gospel. It is the Good News of salvation. Jesus Christ or Jesus the Messiah came to bring the Gospel to a world desperately needing a Savior. When Jesus died on the Cross, we were given the opportunity to be redeemed or restored to a new, right relationship with God. We are given the promise and hope of eternal life. Yet, where did the idea of 'Good News' come from?

It first appears in the Old Testament writings. The word that was used was, Bisorah.

Jesus started his ministry by quoting from Isaiah 61:1-2 "The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to set the oppressed free, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor."

But, there is more to the story. The root word for Bisorah is Basar. This word means cheerful or joyful. When you know you are free from sin, there is an inner joy that cannot be described. It must be experienced. Throughout history, there are countless records and testimonies of people who were often broken by life, beaten down, and defeated who discovered that this experience called salvation, changed the whole course of their lives.

There is also another definition of Bisorah, or the Gospel. It means 'rosy'. It is in connection to one whose cheeks are 'rosy' with life. There is a kind of inner joy or life reflected in their smile, their eyes, and their attitude. They are alive with the presence of God.

When we really live daily in the presence of Jesus, there is a kind of inner 'glow' about us.

Jesus drew people to himself. And we through Jesus can draw people to Jesus because we have the Gospel radiating out through us. Jesus said, 'let your light shine!'
