- I. We are recipients of the faithfulness of God (v. 1)
 - A. God is our refuge in times of trouble

"He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness will be your shield and rampart." (Psalm 91:4)

- B. God is our strength in times of trouble
- C. God is our <u>help</u> in times of trouble

"So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand. " (Isaiah 41:10)

- II. We are blessed with confidence because of God (v. 2-3)
 - A. We don't have to be <u>afraid</u>

"The Lord is with me; I will not be afraid." (Psalm 118:6)

B. We can trust in our faithful God

"Surely God is my salvation; I will trust and not be afraid. 'The Lord, the Lord, is my strength and my song; he has become my salvation." (Isaiah 12:2)

 - A. His presence gives us joy
 - B. His presence gives us stability
 - C. His presence gives us <u>assurance</u>
 - D. His presence gives us courage

"Be strong and courageous. Do not be terrified; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go." (Joshua 1:9)

- IV. We acknowledge the power and majesty of God (v. 8-11)
 - A. We remember what God has done
 - B. We remember the power of God

"I know that you can do all things; no plan of yours can be thwarted." (Job 42:2)

C. We <u>quiet</u> ourselves before God

"The Lord will fight for you; you need only to be still." (Exodus 14:14)

- D. We <u>trust</u> in the only God
- E. We believe in the ultimate triumph of God

"They will make war against the Lamb, but the Lamb will overcome them because he is Lord of Lords and King of kings – and with him will be his called, chosen and faithful followers." (Revelation 17:14)

F. We live in the presence of Almighty God
