- I. Those who look for Jesus will find him
 - A. We must desire to find him

"You will seek me and find me when you seek me with your whole heart." (Jeremiah 29:13)

- B. We must expect to find him
- II. Those who find Jesus must receive him
 - A. We receive Jesus by faith
- *Picture of Simeon holding Jesus
 - B. We receive <u>hope</u> to live with

"In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead." (I Peter 1:3)

C. We receive peace to die with

"I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live even though he dies." (John 11:25)

- III. Those who receive Jesus should praise him
 - A. We praise him for his sovereign rule
 - B. We praise him for his <u>faithfulness</u>
 - C. We praise him for his salvation

"This is good, and pleases God our Savior, who wants all men to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth." (I Timothy 2:4)

- IV. Those who praise Jesus should follow him
 - A. We must listen to the Holy Spirit
 - B. We must obey the Holy Spirit

"Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit" (Galatians 5:25)

- V. Those who find Jesus should worship him
 - A. We worship as we trust in God's word
 - B. We worship as we focus on God

"Look to the Lord and his strength; seek his face always." (Psalm 105:4)

- C. We worship as we fast and pray
- D. We worship as we recognize <u>God's presence</u>
- E. We worship as we give thanks to God

"Give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus." (I Thessalonians 5:18)

F. We worship as we give testimony

"We cannot help speaking about what we have seen and heard." (Acts 4:20)
