I. Disciples of Jesus love him above all

"Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength." (Deuteronomy 6:4-5)

- A. We are to love Jesus more than <u>our families</u>
- B. We are to love Jesus more than ourselves
- II. Disciples of Jesus <u>carry his cross</u>
  - A. We openly identify with Jesus

"I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile." (Romans 1:16)

B. We must die out to self will

"I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me." (Galatians 2:20)

- C. We daily surrender to his will
- D. We live obedient to Jesus
- III. Disciples of Jesus count the cost
  - A. We must understand the cost of discipleship
  - B. We are committed to finishing well

"I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith." (2 Timothy 4:7)

- IV. Disciples of Jesus surrender all to him
  - A. We surrender all that we are to Jesus

"Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God – this is your spiritual act of worship." (Romans 12:1)

"For whoever wants to save his life will lost it, but whoever loses his life for me will find it." (Matthew 16:25)

B. We surrender all that we own to Jesus

"What is more, I consider everything a loss compared to the surpassing greatness of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for who sake I have lost all things. I consider them rubbish that I may gain Christ." (Philippians 3:8)
