- I. The lost condition of people
  - A. We are separated from God because of sin

"We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us have turned to his own way." (Isaiah 53:6)

B. We are separated from eternal life

"Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on him." (John 3:36)

- C. We are separated from our purpose
- D. We are in great danger
- II. The loving heart of the Father seeks us

"Then the man and his wife heard the sound of the Lord God as he was walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and they hid from the Lord God among the trees of the garden. But the Lord God called to the man, 'Where are you?' (Genesis 3:8-9)

A. We are of great value to God

"For God so loved the world that what he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall nor perish but have eternal life." (John 3:16)

B. God searches earnestly for us

"This is what the Sovereign Lord says; 'I myself will search for my sheep and look after them." (Ezekiel 34:11)

C. God searches persistently for us

"In the same way your Father in heaven is not willing that any of these little ones should be lost." (Matthew 18:14)

III. The desire of God is for us to be found

"He is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance." (2 Peter 3:9)

A. God sent Jesus to find lost people
