Part 2 Attitude Adjustment -- Extended

Phillippians 2:12-18

1. Obedience is required at all times and all circumstances. (vs12)

Therefore, brethren, be even more diligent to make your call and election sure, for if you do these things you will never stumble. 2 Peter 1.10

2. We are to complete our salvation. (vs12)

But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him be the glory, both now and to the day of eternity, Amen. 2 Peter 3.18

3. Our progress in salvation will be characterized by "fear and trembling". (vs12)

Therefore, since a promise remains of entering His rest, let us fear lest any of you seen to have come short of it. Hebrews 4.1

4. God provides the desire to complete salvation. (vs13)

(Jesus) was saying, "For this reason I have said to you, that no one can come to Me unless it has been granted him from the Father." John 6.65

5. God provides the <u>power</u> to complete salvation. (vs13)

For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; not as a result of works so that no one may boast. Ephesians 2.8

6. Our actions must be without complaining and disputing. (vs14)

Be hospitable to one another without complaint. 1 Peter 4.8

7. Believers are to work out salvation by working at being <u>pure</u>. (vs15)

Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you entirely; and may your spirit and soul and body be preserved complete, without blame at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. 1 Thessalonians 5.23

8. We live our lives of salvation in a crooked and perverse society. (vs15)

... from among your own selves men will arise, speaking perverse things, to draw away the disciples after them. Acts 20.30

9. Our witness to the world is one of shining as lights and holding fast the word of life. (vs15,16)

Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works and glorify your

Father who is in heaven. Matt 5.16

10. This attitude will result in rejoicing at the judgment day. (vs16,17)

Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, rejoice! Philippians 4.4
