"God is Spirit, and his worshippers must worship in spirit and truth." (John 4:24)

D. True believers glory in Christ

"But by the grace of God I am what I am, and his grace to me was not without effect." (I Corinthians 15:10)

- E. True believers do not <u>trust in themselves</u>
- II. The religious credits do not impress God (v. 4-6)
 - A. Salvation is not by <u>religious ritual</u>
 - B. Salvation is not by belonging to a <u>certain race</u>
 - C. Salvation is not by <u>human importance</u>
 - D. Salvation is not by <u>following tradition</u>
 - E. Salvation is not by <u>religious observance</u>
 - F. Salvation is not by <u>sincerity to a cause</u>
 - G. Salvation is not by <u>following the law</u>
- III. A right relationship with God comes from knowing Christ (v. 7-9)
 - A. To know Christ we forsake all hope of <u>self-righteousness</u>

"For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith – and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God not by works, so that no one can boast." (Ephesians 2:8-9)

B. To know Christ is our highest privilege

"The Kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field. When a man found it, he hid it again, and then in his joy went and sold all he had and bought that field." (Matthew 13:44)

C. To know Christ is to enter into a personal relationship

"Now this is eternal life: that they may know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent." (John 17:3)

D. To know Christ is to have true righteousness

"This righteousness from God comes through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believes." (Romans 3:22)

E. To know Christ is entered into by <u>faith</u>

"Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ." (Romans 5:1)
