A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

It's April and I love this time of year. We get to see the plants begin to bud, it starts to warm up, and we draw close to Resurrection Sunday! I love preaching about Jesus and his death and resurrection. Typically, during Holy Week, the message of Easter is kept within the geographical location of Jerusalem. It was where Jesus was going. But it wasn't where he stopped.

The message of the resurrection doesn't stop at the cross, nor the empty tomb. The resurrection reaches beyond Jerusalem and into this fallen world. Jesus commissioned the Apostles to go and make disciples; to go and tell the world the good news of Jesus, that he is alive. And they did.

You will find that every message preached in the Book of Acts is about the resurrection of Jesus. The message was never five simple steps to feel better or happy. It was about the fact that Jesus was and is alive. The resurrection of Jesus overturned death and thus turns the world right side up. And that simple truth changes everything.

On one occasion, the apostle Paul and his companions were accused of turning the world "upside down" (Acts 17:6). Obviously, those who are spiritually blind would see things that way. When you're speaking the truth and doing good, those who are used to evil patterns see good as evil, because it interrupts what they consider normal.

This is our mission as followers of Jesus: to interrupt evil. The gospel interrupts lies and reveals truth. It infiltrates some of the darkest areas of this world and brings light; and ultimately intercepts spiritual death and gives life.

So, how can we turn the world right side up? I would simply say, live filled with the love of God. Children can easily do this (as well as adults) by being kind to those left out at school or work, inviting someone new into your friend groups. Bring truth and wisdom to people living in chaos. Share your testimony. Be a caring voice through a text message or card. Help someone in need. Invite someone to coffee. Pray and cry with someone. Extend forgiveness. And get out of your comfort zone to show the love of God in a world filled with hate.

With that I leave you with homework. As we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus this year, let's continue to live in such a way that turns the world right side up.
