FROM THE HEART OF THE PASTOR

was reading with some kids at Iowa Elementary School this week, and the cover of the reader we were using had cute bunnies on it. The book talked about how the bunnies "Hop! Hop!" It struck me as I asked the kids about the cover of the book and about the bunnies that many children think of Easter as only being about bunnies, baskets, eggs, and candy. So many in our society today have not heard or don't recognize the true reason for Easter and that it is a celebration of the resurrection of Christ.

As we interact with our neighbors and the community, I encourage you to be mindful that this post-Christian culture often does not acknowledge or know that there is a faith-based significance to holidays like Easter. What can we do to help people learn about the hope we have in Jesus?

PRAY: Begin praying today for your neighbors and others God has placed in your path, asking Him to guide you in sharing the truth of Christ and the hope of the resurrection with them.

SHARE: Be prepared to share your redemption story, how God saved you, and what He saved you from. Be ready to share how that redemption story lives on in your life. Sharing what God has done and is doing in your life is what God calls us to do as His witnesses.

INVITE: Invite people to know Jesus. This often happens over time as you consistently interact with them. This may include inviting them to church to participate in services and activities where we celebrate the Resurrection and share the Good News. Consider inviting those God has laid on your heart to join you at the Seder Dinner, the Family Easter Event, the Good Friday service, and our Resurrection Day services and breakfast (all details are in this newsletter).

God has placed you where you are for His purpose. You interact and connect with people that He is drawing to Himself. Ask God to help you share His love with people who need to know that Easter is not just about bunnies and candy, but it is about a love story that never ends and will transform their lives in the most beautiful way, all because of Jesus.
