his Sunday I'll be preaching on the cost of freedom. The early Americans made many sacrifices and there have been ongoing sacrifices to maintain that freedom, because it can be lost. President Ronald Reagan pointed to this in a speech he gave over 50 years ago. He said, "If we lose freedom here, there is no place to escape to. This is the last stand on earth."
