

FROM THE HEART OF THE PASTOR

If you've ever been combat fishing on the Russian River in Alaska, you know it's not your average quiet day on the water. Shoulder to shoulder with strangers, rods swinging, lines tangling, boots slipping on wet rocks—it's fishing at its wildest.

And yet, in this intense and often frustrating chaos, there's a powerful spiritual metaphor: God calls us to fish not in calm waters, but in the messiness of real life. Here are four things I observed and learned while participating in this event in Alaska.

1. Fishing in Close Quarters - When Jesus called His disciples to become "fishers of men," He wasn't calling them to a peaceful retreat. He was sending them into the crowded, noisy, complicated world—full of spiritual entanglements, resistance, and confusion.

Combat fishing demands focus amid distraction, patience among people, and grace when lines cross. Similarly, Christian witness requires:

Courage to stand shoulder to shoulder with the broken.

Endurance to keep casting truth in a spiritually chaotic world.

Humility to deal graciously with tangled lives.

- 2. The One that Got Away In combat fishing, you don't always land what you hook. Sometimes the fish slip away. In the same way, not every effort to share Christ leads to immediate fruit. But Jesus never told us to measure success by results—just by faithfulness. "Let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up." Galatians 6:9
- 3. Stay Anchored In those Alaskan rivers, one misstep can sweep you downstream. In combat fishing—and in life—you need a firm footing. Spiritually, that foundation is Christ.
- "God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble." Psalm 46:1 Staying rooted in prayer, the Word, and fellowship helps you stand firm, even when life gets turbulent.
- 4. The Joy of the Catch Despite the chaos, when you finally land a silver salmon, there's exhilaration. The same joy is echoed in heaven when one sinner repents. "There is rejoicing in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents." Luke 15:10

The reward of kingdom fishing isn't in our glory—it's in God's. We join heaven in celebrating lives changed for eternity.

Closing Thought:

Combat fishing is unpredictable, messy, and exhausting—but it's worth it. So is the Christian life. Jesus has called us not to comfort, but to engagement—to cast our nets in the fray, knowing He is with us, empowering us, and preparing a harvest we may not yet see. So put on your spiritual waders, grab your Gospel rod, and fish on—even when it's combat.
